



Code of Conduct – Junior Players

All players / parents of children under the age of 18 are required to read, agree and sign this code of conduct. The coach or manager of the team will co-sign this code of conduct. If you have any concerns with this, please speak to your team manager or coach.

- Follow the laws of the game.
- Never argue with an official - if you need clarification, have your captain approach the referee or your coach during a break / after the game.
- Be a good sport - applaud all good plays whether they are made by your team or the opposition. Shake hands after the game.
- Acknowledge officials and volunteers - thank the referee and all volunteers.
- Cooperate with your coach and manager - without them there would be no competition.
- Participate for your own enjoyment and fun - not just to please others.
- Play fair - no verbal abuse of officials, sledging other players or deliberately distracting or provoking an opponent.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants - regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- Speak up - if you have an issue, feel unsafe or are concerned about someone else. Talk to an adult you trust.
- Help out during the year with field set up and clean up.
- Represent the club with pride at all times.
- Approach training as if it was a game. Play to the best of your ability and participate in all activities.
- Do not post negative comments or images, bully, criticise or make derogatory remarks on any social media platform.
- Never behave in a way that could bring Casuarina Beach Rugby Club into disrepute.
